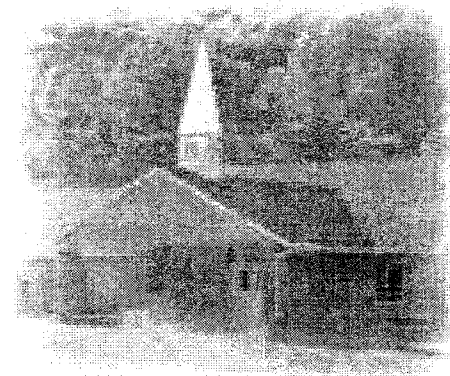
Church Dinners and Fellowships – All through the year, opportunities are provided for casual fellowship times at church dinners, picnics, and special events.

Childrens' Ministries of Wellsville Bible Church . . .

At Wellsville Bible Church, it is our desire to develop deep and caring relationships. We have a great concern for the children of our community and seek to serve them in a number of ways. Along with our Sunday School Ministry where we also offer a safe and loving environment for your nursery age children, following is an introduction to the various ministries of our church:

Monday Night Bible Study – is held at the church and offers a more personal time to study the Bible, ask questions, and fellowship.

Release Time – Children from Wellsville Elementary School are transported to our church on Tuesday afternoons for a Bible Education session. These classes occur when the Wellsville Schools are in session.

Family Night – Tuesdays, starting September 22, 2009. Several ministries will take place at this time. These include:

Kids' Klub – meets every Tuesday night when the Wellsville Schools are in session. Kids' Klub is an opportunity for children in grades K-6 to come and have fun learning about God, singing, playing games, and enjoying a craft and refreshment time.

Teen Bible Study – Teens gathering to learn more about God's Word.

Son Spot – Sunday nights 6:00, meeting at the United Methodist Church - The community youth group for teens in grades 6-12. Several local churches have joined together to encourage and develop our precious resource, Christian teens. At Son Spot they are taught biblical truths, have opportunity to fellowship with other Christians through music, games and "hang out" time, and are encouraged to reach out to their unsaved friends.

Vacation Bible School – held every summer, is a one-week evening Bible school. This ministry reaches numerous children in our community, resulting in many opportunities to minister to parents, as well.
